#### THE PROGRAM



Junior Leadership kicks off with a reception at the Chamber with the participants, Directors of the Chamber, Leadership Lake Norman Alumni, and various elected municipal officials. This is followed by a one-day retreat combining team building and diversity training. The program continues for six months in one-day sessions.

Area leaders in business, government, media, education, health care, and tourism enlighten the participants about the resources, infrastructure, and facilities available to Lake Norman citizens. During each session the group will look at topics ranging from crime and law to community infrastructure.

Junior Leadership Lake Norman is a program sponsored by the Lake Norman Chamber to develop a group of informed, committed, and qualified young individuals capable of providing visionary and progressive leadership for their futures as well as the Lake Norman Region.

The program is an in-depth study of management styles, personalities, and involved activities to illustrate positive leadership opportunities. Taking place over a seven-month period, participants in Junior Leadership Lake Norman have a chance to tour facilities, participate in informative seminars, and are enlightened to the resources available to them in the greater Lake Norman area.

# THE REQUIREMENTS



Participants in the Junior Leadership Lake Norman program are required to attend the retreat and the Graduation exercise. All other sessions are required with only ONE ABSENCE allowed. Please note the dates of the program and schedule them on your calendar making school staff aware of the leadership sessions.

Attendance requirements reflect the commitment necessary to receive a meaningful experience from your investment in the program.

Casual dress is recommended at all sessions with the exception of the Graduation. Typical day runs from 8 am to 2 pm with some sessions ending at 1:30 pm.

### **TO APPLY**

The program enrollment is limited to twenty-one (21) participants. Candidates are selected on the basis of their previous and potential leadership abilities and community involvement. Applications must be received by , Sept 26 at 5:00 pm to be eligible for the program. They can be emailed to:
